THREE PILLARS OF A GIVING REVIEW :

- INFORM
- INSPIRE
- INVITE



INFORM:

- Last Year's Income
- How was it spent (% rather than actual)
- Impact
- Mission Plan for the year ahead
- Budget to be met identify potential shortfall (worst case scenario)
- Impact
- Common Fund Explanation (Fixed Cost Model divided by Membership)
 - Play the Common Fund Video
- Welcome Packs for new "regular" worshippers
- Pew tools Giving Cards, Bank Details, Gift Aid Envelopes & GA Forms
- Giving tools As above + Gift Aid Declarations, Contactless & Other Digital channels

INSPIRE :

- Discipleship (teaching/bible study throughout year)
- Thank You for your generosity (personal letter / periodic update in notice sheet etc)
- Lead by example be a giving church members can vote on who to support at APCM
- Encourage participation Time & Talents as well as Treasure
- Testimony who has benefitted/outcomes (people give to people / relationships)
- Communicate how legacies have been used and the difference they've made (IMPACT)
- What is possible "IF......" (particularly legacies but not limited to these)
- Home group courses/materials Giving In Grace (<u>www.givingingrace.org</u>)
 / 6 Steps in Christian Giving / Giving for Life (available from diocese)

INVITE :

- Be a part of what's happening in THIS church time / talents / treasure
- By Example People more often than not follow what they see others doing bear in mind if you have high turnover of visitors.
- Formal Response (so all can be included involve church council members to make it personal *be clear that EVERYONE is being invited to respond*)
- Pledge Cards/slips
- Use 'Six Steps' encourage progression to next 'type of giver'
- Gift Aid Declaration (always available to maximise contributions)
- Inflationary Increase Reminder (if not planning to do annual PGR) Simple letter encouraging standing order giving & suggested increase (similar to PGS)
- Initial teaching/invitation within 'welcome' packs for new members
- 'survival' packs for existing members
- <u>Have the right TOOLS available</u> don't miss out on giving due to lack of cash
- Promote legacy giving posters / legacy workshops


